PACKING TIPS

- Uniforms should be worn at the opening and closing ceremonies
- The weather in the Netherlands can be unpredictable, make sure to bring a rain jacket and waterproof shoes.
- For the Rotterdam evening we have an action-packed program. Make sure to pack according to the instructions that come with your registration for the different activities.
- Please check with your airline what is allowed in your hand luggage, and what is allowed in the cabin luggage. The organisers cannot be held liable for any losses from your failure to abide by airline rules!

VISA

It is the responsibility of the individual participants and/or their member organisation to check if they require a visa to travel to and enter The Netherlands.

The competent authority of the individual's country will provide relevant information. Complimentary information is available on the website of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of The Netherlands.

Should you require a visa please make sure to request it well in advance as applications submitted to the Dutch authorities later than three months before the expected date of entry will not be considered. The host team will issue a letter in support of a visa application upon request addressed to the Joint Conference Secretariat. Please note that such a letter will only be provided once a participant is duly registered.

TRANSPORT

Rotterdam is easily accessible by train, bus, boat, car and plane. Please consider travelling sustainably by <u>train</u> or if you need to take your car travel together.

Rotterdam is a walkable city. Everything you need to know about public transport in Rotterdam can be found on the website of <u>9292</u>. Tickets can be bought online, inside the bus/tram or at the metro station.

From the conference centre to the nearest train station is a 5-minute walk. Here you will also find the nearest bus- and metro station. The nearest tramstation is Rotterdam Kruisplein which is a 2-minute walk.

The Netherlands is the number 33 in the ranking of <u>safest countries in the</u> <u>world</u>. The overall risk in Rotterdam is low. There is a risk of pickpocketing in the inner city so keep your valuables safe.

It is not usual to pay with a credit card (master card/visa) in the Netherlands, in general, they are not accepted at stores. Most places accept debit cards (Maestro) and cash.

In the streets always watch out for bikes, there are many of them everywhere. Biking is one of the main means of transportation in the Netherlands. Bike lanes are usually indicated by red-coloured roads. If you rent a bike, make sure to lock it properly because bike theft is prevalent in The Netherlands.

There are neighbourhoods to avoid namely Charleroi and Feyenoord, which are across the Erasmus bridge. Additionally, Delfshaven and Schiedam are not the most pleasant either. Travelling alone in Rotterdam is very safe for women. Just avoid poorly lit and deserted areas and always walk together at night.

ACCOMMODATION





THINGS TO CONSIDER IN THE NETHERLANDS

- In the Netherlands all tap water can be drunk directly from the tap. It is safe to do so.
- It is required by law to have your passport or ID card with you.
- The Netherlands is known for its many cyclists. Watch out for them on the streets and pavements, they don't always give way.
- · Avoid going to parks at night alone.
- As Rotterdam is a big city, petty crimes such as pickpocketing and bag snatching are issues to be aware of. Ensure that your personal belongings are secured and never keep your baggage or other belongings unattended.
- Demonstrations: Rotterdam is occasionally the scene of large demonstrations. We advise avoiding the areas in which demonstrations or other large manifestations take place.

Fun facts about Rotterdam

- Rotterdam is famous for its unique architecture.
 Have a look around the city and discover it yourself!
- The roof of the Markthal has the largest piece of art in the world.
- Rotterdam is home to over 170 different nationalities.
- Over 40 different scouts and guide groups are located in Rotterdam
- Kapsalon, a Dutch "delicacy" was invented in Rotterdam. It is a plate of fries, cheese, lettuce and doner meat (lamb, kebab or chicken).
 It is especially popular as a snack during or after a night of partying.
- The Dutch humanist Erasmus was born in Rotterdam. A lot of buildings and institutions are named after him. Such as the Erasmus hospital and Erasmus bridge.
- The Euromast is the tallest, public accessible tower in the Netherlands.
 With a height of 185 meters you'll be able to enjoy amazing views. Did you know that it is even possible to go abseiling from the Euromast?
- There are many modes of transportation in Rotterdam. One of them is the water taxi. This taxi will take you across the river and in the meantime, you can enjoy the view!
- Historic Delfshaven: This picturesque marina is one of the few parts of the old town that survived the bombing of Rotterdam in 1940.

An introduction to the city of Rotterdam

Rotterdam is one of the largest cities in the Netherlands with approximately 650 thousand inhabitants. The city is best known for having the largest seaport in Europe. In Rotterdam, you can see mostly new construction and modern buildings. Due to heavy bombardments on May 14, 1940, almost nothing of the old city centre is left. The Laurenskerk, where the opening ceremony is held, is the only remnant of the city centre of Rotterdam.

Moving around Rotterdam is possible by public transport (tram, bus and metro) or by water taxi, of which there are about 10.

Do you want to get familiar with typical Dutch dishes? Try the kapsalon, this culinary masterpiece was invented in Rotterdam.
